Mr. Numrych successfully defended complex insurance coverage declaratory judgment actions in the District of Columbia, Maryland, and Virginia that resulted in published opinions, and trial verdicts in favor of his clients. *State Farm et al. v. Enterprise Leasing Company et al.*, *The Washington Daily Law Reporter*, Vol. 127, No. 78, p. 721 (1999), *Richard Lipsky v. Wausau Insurance et al.*, (2003, Arlington Virginia Chancery Court, No. 00371).

Other complex product liability cases he handled in the Federal District Courts also resulted in published opinions. *National Coach Works et al. v. Detroit Diesel Corporation et al.*, 128 F. Supp. 2d 821 (D.Ct. Md. 2001). He served as trial counsel in several cases in the past few years, which resulted defense verdicts in favor of his clients at trial.
